COMMUNION AT THE ALTAR

June 17, July 1 and 15, August 5 and 19.

You may have wine or grape juice for communion and you may take communion by individual glass or by the common Challis. The ushers will guide people out of the pews as they normally do. When you walk up the main aisle there will be a tray of small glasses near the front pews. Grape juice will be in the center glasses, the others will be empty. If you want an individual glass please take one and continue up to the altar. Nothing is needed for common cup. Stand at the altar until Pastor motions to kneel, if you can. The Pastor serves the wafer, followed by 2 worship assistants, one will fill your glass with wine if empty, and the second will serve wine from the challis. An acolyte will follow with an empty tray to collect the empty glasses. After all at the rail have been served Pastor will say a blessing and dismiss all at the table. You will then return to your pew using the outside aisles, allowing the next group to go up to the altar by the main aisle.

On the 1st and 3rd Sundays we will be having communion at the altar. The 2nd, 4th and 5th we will have communion by Intinction. (dipping wafer into the wine)
