Pastor's Message

Life on the Edge of Faith

Spring is in the air. And Lent is coming! For this Lenten season, we are treated to a meditative series every Thursday at 2 pm and then 7 pm. The title of the series is "Life on the Edge of Faith" written by The Rev. Beth Huener, an ELCA pastor from Ohio.

Jesus' suffering and his death on the cross is the central focus of our faith. Every year, during Lent, and particularly during the Holy Week, we read the stories from the perspectives of the four Gospel – Matthew, Mark, Luke and John. And stories are told from the experiences of the main characters, such as Peter, John, James, etc. They are the main characters because they were closest to Jesus and to the events that were unfolded. For the disciples involved, what they have witnessed – Jesus' gruesome and unjust death, as well as his glorious resurrection – is life changing. God's story through Jesus has transformed them.

But an event like this might have been just as thought-provoking, and even faith-shaking for those who were not as close to Jesus or were simply at the peripheral of the events that took place. What were they thinking? More importantly, how would their experience inspire our own faith journey? Giving voice to those the Biblical writers did not narrate in detail is the project that Pr. Huener takes on in this series. Through monologues by some of our members, we will learn about the thoughts of a sleeping disciple, the high priest, a maid, a soldier and a city resident.

The journey of faith is complicated and rich. Sometimes, we may have a strong sense of closeness with God through Christ, with the Scriptures, as well as our church and our fellow church members. But other times, we might feel like we are on the peripheral looking inside, with doubts and questions. The zigzagging between closeness and distance, between being at the inner circle and at the peripheral, is how we grow in faith.

So come and join us! Come and put ourselves in the shoes of those who were further removed from the main characters and the main events. Come either at 2 pm or 7 pm every Thursday after Ash Wednesday!







FAMILY RECIPES

Meatless Chili Mac

Ingredients

- 1 large onion, chopped
- 1 medium green pepper, chopped
- 1 tablespoon olive oil
- 1 garlic clove, minced
- · 2 cups water
- 1-1/2 cups uncooked elbow macaroni
- 1 can (16 ounces) mild chili beans, undrained
- 1 can (15-1/2 ounces) great northern beans, rinsed and drained
- 1 can (14-1/2 ounces) diced tomatoes, undrained
- 1 can (8 ounces) tomato sauce
- · 4 teaspoons chili powder
- 1 teaspoon ground cumin
- 1/2 teaspoon salt
- 1/2 cup fat-free sour cream

Directions

- In a Dutch oven, saute onion and green pepper in oil until tender. Add garlic; cook 1 minute longer. Stir in the water, macaroni, beans, tomatoes, tomato sauce, chili powder, cumin and salt.
- 2 Bring to a boil. Reduce heat; cover and simmer for 15-20 minutes or until macaroni is tender. Top each serving with 1 tablespoon sour cream.
